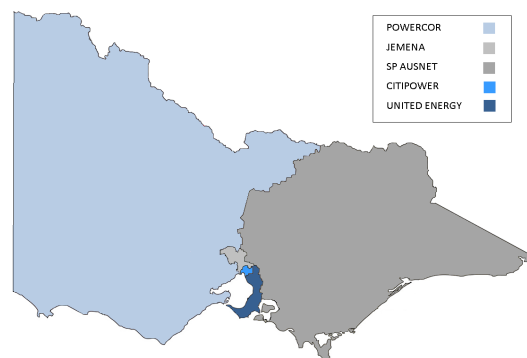


# Electricity Price Update

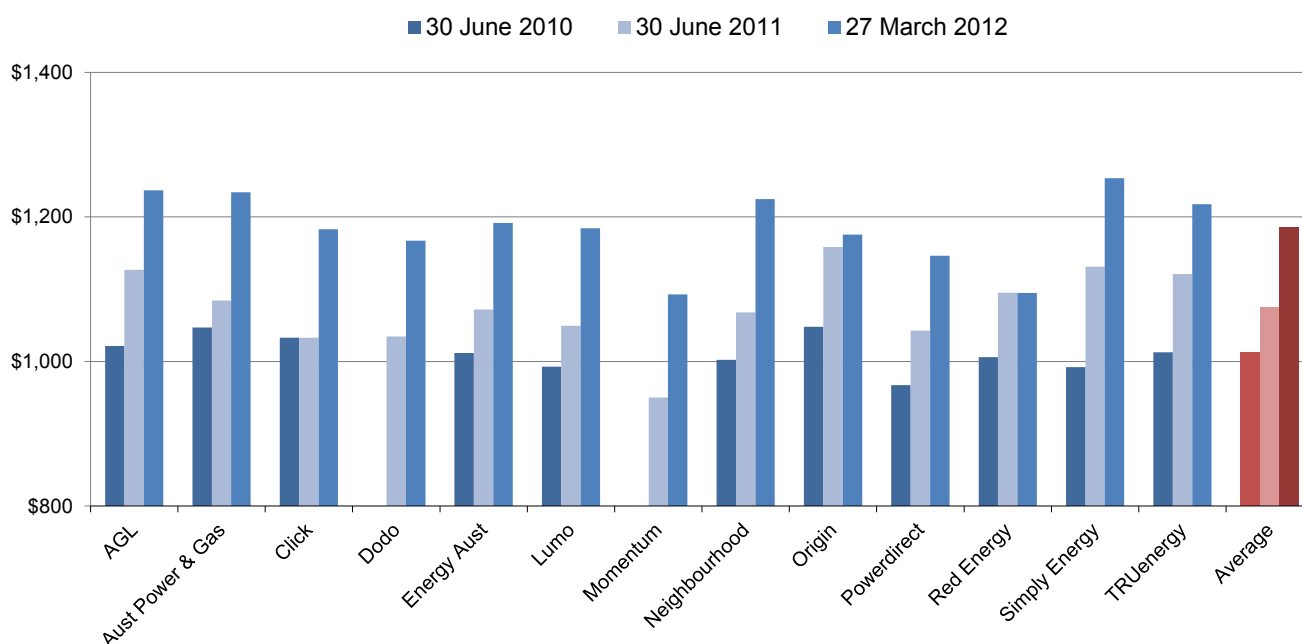

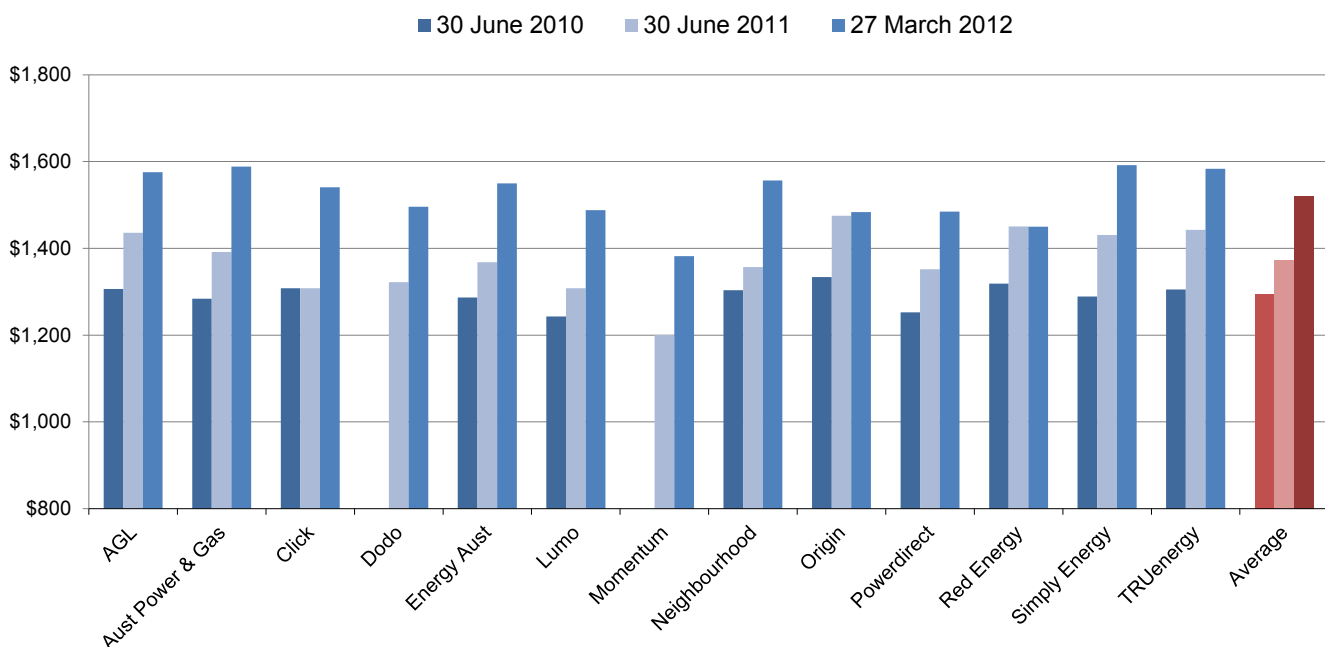
