1. What do you think of the proposed minimum feed-in tariff for 2020-21?

Providing customers with certainty around feed-in tariffs is extremely useful in encouraging behind the meter solar generation.

The tariff should be reviewed regularly to ensure that it is kept in line with the current generation price, i.e. as prices go down due to increased penetration of renewables, the tariff changes accordingly.
