Thank you for your letter of the 27th April 2022 and in reference to the foreshadowed changes to the Victorian energy retail licences.

We broadly support reviews aimed at alignment and consistency across the issued licences, particularly in the evolving energy market. This we see as core to promoting consistency in regulation. Furthermore, we support the Commission's objectives in facilitating effective and competitive markets in the long-term interests of Victorian consumers.

We acknowledge the revised documentation provided for in the letter of the 27th April, 2022 and agree with the proposed documents;

- Revised Template Electricity Licence
- Standard Electricity Licence Conditions for Electricity Retail.

Further we note the proposed removal of the special condition 3.2 existing with MTA's existing licence, proposed within the ESC's initial correspondence of the 31st January 2022 and consent to this removal and variation of our licence consistent with the implementation of the revised documents above.
