#### **EPA Victoria: Our Process**

- EPA as an environmental regulator has obligations on the water industry.
- EPA's guidance will provide a statement of environmental obligations for the industry to identify funding needs.

#### EPA Process in preparing obligation statement

- Draft Guidance July 2011
- Consultation workshop if required
- Final guidance August 2011
- One-on one discussions with businesses to mid 2012.

Enhance the intelligence and communication of environmental quality and its drivers and impacts




## Compliance and Enforcement Policy

Policy released June 2011 articulates EPA's approach to:

- methods and priorities for ensuring compliance with our Acts
- carrying out compliance and enforcement activities

EPA will balance using our influence and enforcement tools to:

- Achieve compliance
- Uphold environmental standards
- Drive environmental improvement



- EPA DSE review of the Statutory Policy framework
- Seeking to provide more responsive, accessible guidelines with greater clarity of obligations

- Consultation underway

### Areas of focus for EPA

#### Some examples:

- The current status of compliance with current obligations
- Occurrences of emergency discharge (30As)
- Sewer overflows
- Biosolids
- Evidence of adaptive management
