Thank you for the opportunity to comment. I am a resident in Moonee Valley with a 4KW solar PV system. From the point of view of our family finances, this reduction in the minimum FIT will likely impact us negatively. Of course, if there was more competition in FIT tariffs across retailers, this may not have such a negative impact, but there is not much evidence of this happening yet. Perhaps we could wait to see some positive competition in FITs across the industry before redistributing this income from citizens to private electricity retailers?
