Your comments on this draft decision:

The feed in Tariff should be going up not down. Why shouldn't it match the wholesale price? There is no difference between a consumer investing in power generation and a business investing in power generation. Does that mean a large business investing in solar generation will also only get 7.1c/kWh? I don't think so. We need to encourage people to invest not discourage it.
