

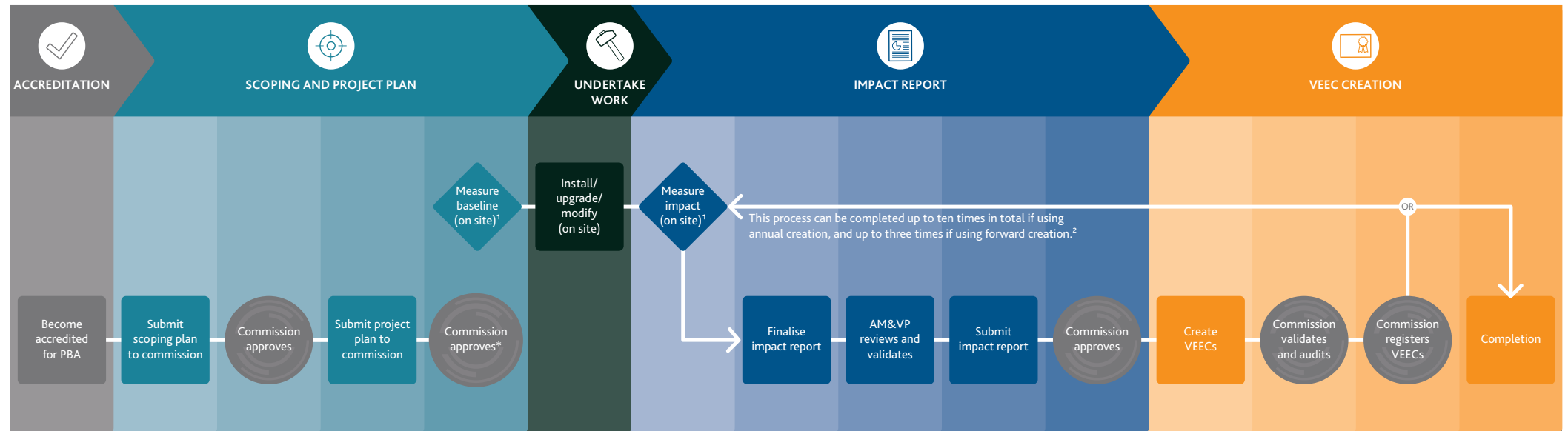
# Project-based activities process map: measurement and verification

This process map shows the steps businesses must follow to receive Victorian energy efficiency certificates (VEECs) using the measurement and verification method.

We may elect to do a site inspection at certain stages of this process.

While this process map shows the scoping plan and project plan being completed separately, you can opt to submit them to us at the same time. However, you will still need to wait for the scoping plan to be approved prior to starting work on site.
