Subject: Non omni-directional lamp transition period for activity 21A

Dear VEU team,

I am writing on behalf of EcoMatters Technologies in regards to the Non-omnidirectional lamp transition period.

We believe a minimum three-month extension should be granted to the APs and product suppliers for the following reasons:

1. Activity 21 is progressing relatively slow. Some APs have spent a long time setting up the process and workflow as the 21A is a new activity. Some APs have pre-ordered a large number of products. They are struggling to finish the old stock before the end of June.
2. As a product supplier. We have not had any complaint in regards to the beam angle or light distribution of the 21A products so far. From the feedback we have received in the past four months, the non-Omnidirectional product is not causing any issues to the customer/end user.
3. Both APs and the product supplies need more time to finish their existing stock as they were pre-ordered before the release of the regulation of the omnidirectional lamp.

Based on our observation and the feedbacks from numbers of APs and Electricians, We believe a minimum of a three-month transitional period should be considered.
