**REVOCATION OF ELECTRICITY TRANSMISSION LICENCE**

## SUMMARY

Pursuant to section 29(3) of the Electricity Industry Act 2000 (EI Act), the Essential Services Commission (the commission) has revoked the electricity transmission licence of Lumea Pty Limited (ACN 626 136 865) as trustee for Lumea Trust (ABN 94 121 353 950) (Lumea) granted on 4 December 2019 in relation to the transmission assets associated with the Kiamal Solar Farm and Kiamal Terminal Station (Kiamal Transmission Assets) (Kiamal Licence).

## BACKGROUND

Lumea is the holder of three electricity transmission licences issued by the commission. Lumea has requested that two electricity transmission licences be consolidated.

The Kiamal Licence is in relation to the Kiamal Transmission Assets. The other electricity transmission licence is in relation to Berrybank Wind Farm and Berrybank Terminal Station (Berrybank Transmission Assets) (Berrybank Licence).

On 24 January 2024, Lumea wrote to the commission requesting the Kiamal Licence and the Berrybank Licence be consolidated into one licence.

On 17 January 2025, Lumea agreed to the variation of the Berrybank Licence to include the Kiamal Assets.

On 10 March 2025, Lumea agreed to the revocation of the Kiamal Licence.

## CONSIDERATION BY THE COMMISSION

Section 29(3) of the EI Act provides that the commission may revoke a licence in accordance with the procedures specified in the licence conditions.

## DECISION

In accordance with section 29(3) of the EI Act and having regard to the commission's objectives under the Essential Services Commission Act 2001 and the EI Act, the delegate of the commission has decided to revoke the Kiamal Licence.
