VARIATION OF A LICENCE TO GENERATE AND SELL ELECTRICITY**

**Origin Energy Power Limited (ACN 008 289 398)
– Mortlake Power Station**

RECORD OF DECISION

17 December 2025

SUMMARY

Pursuant to section 29(1)(b) of the Electricity Industry Act 2000 (Vic) (EI Act) the Essential Services Commission (the commission) has varied the licence of Origin Energy Power Limited (ACN 008 289 398) (**Origin**) in respect of the Mortlake Power Station to generate and sell electricity, to include the Mortlake battery energy storage system and other minor updates.

BACKGROUND

On 17 November 2010, Origin was first granted a licence to generate and sell electricity at the Mortlake Power Station.

On 8 August 2025, Origin wrote to the commission requesting to vary the licence to include the Mortlake battery energy storage system.

On 16 December 2025, Origin consented to the proposed variation of the licence.

CONSIDERATION OF THE APPLICATION

Section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act provides that a licence may be varied by agreement between the commission and the licensee.

DECISION

In accordance with section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act and having regard to the commission's objectives under the Essential Services Commission Act 2001 and the EI Act, the commission delegate has decided to vary the licence to include the Mortlake battery energy storage system and other minor updates.
