- monitor and enforce each retailers' compliance and service standards specified in its retail licence and industry codes, and
- publish comparisons of the retailers' performance to inform customers about the service they receive and provide incentives for the retailers to improve their performance relative to one another.

1. Energy markets

This section provides the data from 2018-19 on relevant market activity, such as overall customer numbers, market share and distribution of customers across market or standing offers.

These figures allow the Commission to track the rate at which customers exercise their right to choose between retailers and can provide indication of customer engagement in the market.
