

ELECTRICITY INDUSTRY ACT 2000 VARIATION OF AN ELECTRICITY GENERATION AND SALE LICENCE

Cherry Tree Wind Farm Pty Ltd ACN 134 444 947

RECORD OF DECISION

9 January 2024

SUMMARY

Pursuant to the provisions of section 29(1) of the Electricity Industry Act 2000 (Vic) (Industry Act) the Essential Services Commission (the commission) has varied the licence of Cherry Tree Wind Farm Pty Ltd (ACN 134 444 497) (Cherry Tree) to generate and sell electricity in Victoria.

BACKGROUND

On 22 April 2020, Cherry Tree was first granted a licence to generate and sell electricity in Victoria.

On 17 November 2023, Cherry Tree notified the commission of a change of address for service of notices.

On 4 January 2024, Cherry Tree agreed to the variations to its licence.

CONSIDERATION OF THE APPLICATION

Section 29(1)(b) of the Industry Act provides that a licence may be varied by agreement between the commission and the licensee.

DECISION

In accordance with section 29(1)(b) of the Industry Act and having regard to the commission's objectives under the Essential Services Commission Act 2001 and the Industry Act, the delegate of the commission has decided to vary the licence by agreement with Cherry Tree to change its address for service of notices.
