

ELECTRICITY INDUSTRY ACT 2000 VARIATION OF AN ELECTRICITY DISTRIBUTION LICENCE

Powercor Australia Limited (ACN 064 651 109)

RECORD OF DECISION

19 June 2025

SUMMARY

Pursuant to the provisions of section 29(1) of the Electricity Industry Act 2000 (Vic) (El Act) the Essential Services Commission (the commission) has varied the licence of Powercor Australia Limited (ACN 064 651 109) (Powercor) to distribute electricity in Victoria.

BACKGROUND

On 3 October 1994, Powercor was first granted an electricity distribution licence.

On 17 April 2025, the commission contacted Powercor seeking agreement to vary its licence to include a dispute resolution clause.

On 6 May 2025, Powercor agreed to the variations to its licence.

CONSIDERATION OF THE APPLICATION

Section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act provides that a licence may be varied by agreement between the commission and the licensee.

DECISION

In accordance with section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act and having regard to the commission's objectives under the Essential Services Commission Act 2001 and the EI Act, the delegate of the commission has decided to vary the licence by agreement to include a dispute resolution clause.
