Do you have any comments on the commission's consultation paper?

Have not seen any reference to feed-in tariffs in this consultation paper. Curious whether standing offers should stipulate the minimum feed-in tariff the retail energy customer should be offered. Many of the payback conditions of investment in the government sponsored solar panel rebate schemes is determined by the feed-in tariff available. This is required to ensure public investment inthese renewable energy schemes continues. Moreso, with lack of certainty on availability of low cost storage solutions, the main driver for public investment is the feed-in tariff at this stage. Also at this stage the schemes offering consumers battery system rebates on offer is limited to certain high-demand post codes. This still means some certainty on feed-in tariff levels to consumers from retailers.
