

ELECTRICITY INDUSTRY ACT 2000 VARIATION OF A LICENCE TO GENERATE AND SELL ELECTRICITY

SEC Energy Pty Ltd (ACN 670 408 134)

RECORD OF DECISION

30 July 2025

SUMMARY

Pursuant to section 29(1)(b) of the Electricity Industry Act 2000 (Vic) (El Act) the Essential Services Commission (the commission) has varied the licence of SEC Energy Pty Ltd (ACN 670 408 134) (**SEC**) to change the licensee's address for service of notices to sell electricity by retail in Victoria.

BACKGROUND

On 4 December 2024, SEC was first granted a licence to electricity by retail.

On 17 July 2025, SEC notified the commission of a change of address for service of notices under clause 2.1 of its licence.

On 24 July 2025, SEC agreed to the variation to its licence.

CONSIDERATION OF THE APPLICATION

Section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act provides that a licence may be varied by agreement between the commission and the licensee.

DECISION

In accordance with section 29(1)(b) of the EI Act, the delegate of the commission has decided to vary the licence by agreement with SEC to change the licensee's address for service of notices under clause 2.1 of its licence.
