We keep hearing that we are experiencing a cost of living crisis, so any increase on any bill must be demonstrated to have tangible, useful benefits to those experiencing the increase in charges. Also, tenants pay just as much as owner customers, it is just that some of the cost is hidden in their rent. Developer charges are good, as existing customers should not be subsidising new customers, especially in areas where large scale residential land/or commercial developments are occurring.
