




# How much you need to pay



You must pay for your water services.



We will send you a water bill every 3 months.



Your water bill shows


your account number

how much water you use

how much you need to pay.

The amount you need to pay is in large print on the front of your water bill.





For example

• if you rent you only pay for the water you use



 if you own a house you have to pay extra fees

• you might be able to get a **concession**.



Concession means you have a card from the government. For example, you might get a concession if you

are older




have a disability.

You can ask if you are allowed to get a concession.




### When you need to pay

The day you need to pay is written under the amount you need to pay.



We will send you a water bill every 3 months.



You can ask us to change the day you pay your water bill. For example, you can ask to pay every month.


### How to pay

You can pay your water bill in 7 different ways.



#### 1. Direct debit

Direct debit means we take money from your bank account when your water bill is due.



If you want to pay by direct debit you must

• set it up **before** your water bill is due



have enough money in your bank account to pay.



#### 2. BPay

BPay means you pay online using a code on your water bill.



### 3. Australia Post billpay

You can take your water bill into the post office and pay.



#### 4. On our website

You can visit our website and pay your water bill online.



### 5. Centrepay

You can pay your water bill from your Centrelink payments.



You can call Centrelink for more information.

#### 6. Phone



You can call us to pay your water bill by credit card.




#### 7. Cheque


You can send us a cheque in the mail.

• if you can **not** pay




• if you have problems when you try to pay.
