Dear Commissioners,

Re: Impending Decision on the Feed-In Tariff for 2016

It is with great concern I write to register my objection to your forthcoming decision of the Solar Rebate Feed-in Tariff for 2016.

I feel it is unjust to pay a rebate of \$0.06 per kWh when the electricity supplier charges me \$0.33/kWh for what I use when my household solar system consistently generates more than half my needs, sometimes all of my kW requirements.

I feel the taking of my feed-in power is more than unjust at \$0.06/kWh, it is downright theft and your decision is the basis of this theft. Please re-think and determine a much fairer return rate for 2016.

My annual electricity costs more than 10% of my annual income of \$17,000, for a necessary item of which I generate 75% from my own solar panels!

I have read your draft decision and consider it likened to that of Prince John and the Sheriff of Nottingham and you should be thoroughly ashamed of yourselves.

I request a much fairer and better return from my own solar generated power kWhrs.
