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VTA INTERIM SUBMISSION – VTA OPERATOR SURVEY

1. PURPOSE OF THE SURVEY

This interim submission reveals the results of a survey of 35 large fleet metropolitan taxi operators. The Victorian Taxi Association (VTA) will be presenting another submission that addresses many of the issues raised by the Essential Services Commission (ESC) in the Draft Report – Taxi Fare Review 2007-08. This submission responds only to issues concerning the industries cost structure and the results of the VTA's operator survey.

The VTA has, on numerous occasions, expressed our grave concerns regarding aspects of the ESC's Taxi Fare Review 2007-08. In particular, the VTA has pointed out dramatic errors in Price Waterhouse Cooper's (PwC) *Review of Victorian Taxi Costs* found in appendix C of the ESC Interim Report. In particular, we believe table 3, *Profile of a Median Taxi in 2007 and 2004*, is both wrong and misleading.

The VTA have been quick to point out that this not the fault of PwC. The nature of the respondents (and lack of metropolitan respondents) to their operator survey, that was used to construct table 3, was heavily skewed and flawed data because it was derived from a disproportionate number of particular types of taxi operators — single car operators and country operators. The effect of this is to produce costs that are not representative of the industry as a whole.

In response to this situation the VTA conducted our own survey of large fleet metropolitan operators. Included in this submission is a list their recorded costs in comparison to the PwC data. As the VTA expected the numbers were vastly different in certain areas, justifying our concerns with the PwC data.

2. SURVEY PROCESS

Prior to the release of the Draft Report the VTA commissioned its own survey of 35 metropolitan taxi operators. Of the 35 surveys, the VTA received 15 responses (42%). The 15 respondents operated approximately 700 taxis and bailed approximately 2650 taxi drivers.

Attached for your analysis are copies of:

- The Individual surveys received (see attached CD);
- The data spreadsheet (see attached CD);
- A comparison of the VTA results and PwC results; and
- A copy of the survey sent by the VTA to metropolitan operators.

The survey itself was based on the document used by PwC. Some small changes were made where inappropriate or confusing terminology had been used by PwC (for example the term Green Slip was removed because it refers to a NSW, not Victorian, registration requirement).

The VTA are more than happy to discuss any aspects of this information or the process for gathering it with the ESC or their associates. For commercial reasons the names of the individual respondents have been removed from the survey, however if the ESC have particular questions regarding a survey result the VTA would be happy to act in an intermediary capacity on behalf of the ESC and contact the operator concerned.
